## **Park Ridge Community Star Shines on Maine Township Once Again**

Maine Township Trustee Laura Morask will join five others from Maine Township who have been recognized as a Park Ridge Community Star when she receives the honor from the Park Ridge Chamber of Commerce at “A Night of Stars” Annual Community Star Dinner Saturday, Jan. 19. Established in 2005, the award is given each year to people who have made an outstanding contribution through volunteerism to the quality of life in and around Park Ridge during the previous calendar year.

Others from Maine Township who have been similarly recognized include Supervisor Carol A. Teschky, Clerk Gary K. Warner, Highway Commissioner Robert Provenzano, Former Supervisor Bob Dudycz, and Robert Cohen, Director of the Office of Emergency Management.

Morask, who has been a Maine Township trustee since 2001, has focused her efforts on improving services to both youth and seniors at no cost to the community through creative programs. Her greatest achievement has been to initiate Anti-Gang Education Forums.

“I have been thrilled to see my efforts at involving all facets of our community hit home,” Morask said. “It is thanks to the tremendous level of interagency cooperation in keeping our community truly special that this program has grown from 20 residents to a full capacity crowd over the years.”
