**** Are you a parent with a child-related concern? MaineStay, the Township's Youth Services Department, offers affordable short-term counseling services.**

**** Did you know that if you are over 60 years of age, Senior Information and Assistance may be what you are looking for? Do you have questions on SHIP, Circuit Breaker, or need Nursing Home Assistance? Contact John Ulrey or Diane Franzen at the Town Hall.**

**** Did you know that Maine Township Government offers many services for families and single adults in need? Call General Assistance for help with Public Aid, Social Security, energy assistance, disabled assistance, Section 8 housing, or the government surplus food program.**

**** Did you know that if you are 65 years of age or older and are responsible for the real estate taxes on the property where you reside, you can file for a Senior exemption? Call Assessor Rueckert's Office for more information.**

**** If you are concerned that township codes are not being obeyed. Report your concern to the Code Enforcement Officer.**

**** Did you know that Maine Township has an active Neighborhood Watch program? Neighborhood Watch meets the first Wednesday of every month. Contact Maine Township Hall for more information.**
